- ✔ Be a member, or family [parent(s), grandparent(s), Caregiver(s)...] is a member of the Guyana Ottawa Cultural Association Inc.;
- ✓ Demonstrate a need for financial assistance; and
- ✔ Demonstrate leadership in community service and volunteer activities.

- √ A two-page essay explaining why this scholarship is important to the applicant and how the
 applicant will satisfy the eligibility criteria (e.g., academic achievement, school and community
 service, volunteer activities, education plans and financial need.)
- √ A photocopy of the applicant's latest official transcript of
 - 6 Grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M) or a combination of 6 grade 11 or grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M) with a minimum average of 75%, or
 - University or college courses with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- √ A letter of recommendation from a teacher who taught you in the current academic year or a guidance counsellor.
